B) Eligibility:

- Candidates (both Freshers and Deputed) with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Sciences / Humanities/ Social Science, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent there to are eligible for admission to the programme. Requirement of 50% (fifty) marks shall not apply for persons appointed as teachers prior to the commencement of the NCTE, (Regulations, Norms & Procedure) Second Amendment Regulations, 2010 as laid down at para 8(i) of the aforesaid Gazette. The relaxation of marks for SC/ST/PWD is 5%.
- Deputed teachers teaching for Class IX onwards in W.B. Govt.; Govt. aided and Govt. Sponsored institution are eligible.
- Age limit: 40 years (As on 30th June 2016) for freshers candidate. There is relaxation of age for maximum 5 (five) years for students belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe & Physically Handicapped Categories.
- Candidates pursuing any other Course of Studies/Job/Fulltime Research Work will not be allowed to pursue this course simultaneously.

F) College Hours:

The college will start its normal work at 10.00 a.m. and continue till 5.10 p.m. from Monday to Friday and 10:00 am to 1:45 pm on Saturday.

G) Migration

Students migrating from other university will have to obtain Migration Certificate and submit them within 1(one) month from the date of his/her admission and will have to be registered themselves following the normal rules and regulations of this University.

H) Reservation:

- Reservation of seats and upper age limit will be as per the rules of the Govt. of West Bengal and University of Calcutta.
- SC/ST (Non creamy layer)/PWD candidates who are domicile of West Bengal are entitled to get the reservation facility i.e. SC/ST (Non creamy layer)/PWD candidates hailing from states other than West Bengal are not eligible for such benefits and they are hereby advised to select the Category option as 'General'.
- Reservation of seats for the PWD: 3% of seats are provided for persons with disability having minimum degree of disability to the extent of 40% provided that their physical disability does not come in the way of pursuing the course.
- PWD are required to submit a certificate from a Civil Surgeon of a Govt. Hospital indicating the extent of visual/physical disability and also the extent to which the disability hampers the candidate in pursuing her studies at the time of admission. The candidates under this category may have to undergo a fresh medical examination, if so prescribed by the University, before being admitted.

J) Number of Seat/ Intake Capacity:

- Total Intake capacity: **50**
 - Deputed: **25** & Fresher: **25**
Seats will be filled up with Fresher candidates in case of insufficient Deputed candidates.
 - Home University: 80% & Others University: 20%
20% seats are reserved for other University (Other than University of Calcutta.) candidates. This type of reservation is applicable only for the fresher candidates.
 - Reservation of seats for SC-22%, ST-6%, PWD-3% candidates will be as per Calcutta University and W.B. Govt. Norms.
- Subject-wise and category-wise seat will be announced at the time of declaration of Provisional Merit list.**

K) Admission procedure:

a) Fresher:

Admission will be on the basis of Total Grade Marks against marks obtained in different qualifying examinations and as per norms of University. Scores against marks for different level of examinations and Calculation of Grade Marks will be as follows:

b) Deputed:

Teachers teaching in classes IX to XII only can apply as Deputed Teacher. Selection of Deputed Teacher of Higher Secondary School/Secondary School/Madrasah affiliated to W.B.B.S.E/W.B.B.M.E will be made **on the basis of the period of approved services** in the School/Madrasah. In case applicants having equal service in Secondary School/ Madrasah, preference will be given to the candidates having higher Academic Qualifications. In case of both the Period of Service and Academic Qualifications are equal, selection will be made on the basis of percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in different examinations in their career and candidates having higher total grade marks will be selected (**Grade Marks calculation will be done as meant for fresher candidates.**)

c) Others Rules & Regulation:

- ❖ *Merit list is prepared on the basis of on-line submission of marks by the candidate.* Admission will be done strictly on the basis of actual physical verification of the original documents.
- ❖ ***Published Provisional merit list does not guarantee admission.***
- ❖ ***Admissions will stand closed once the total number of seats available in the college/subject are filled up.***
- ❖ All admissions are strictly provisional subject to final scrutiny and acceptance by the appropriate authorities including Calcutta University by way of issuing of Registration Certificate and Admit Card.
- ❖ The College does not accept responsibility for cancellation of admission due to suppression or misstatement of facts by students at the time of admission. The college shall not be held responsible for cancellation of admission for any reason, whatsoever, by Calcutta University.
- ❖ While every care is taken in preparing the Merit List, in the event of any inadvertent mistake or omission, the college will not be responsible in any way. However, any error/omission may be brought to the notice of the Principal in writing.

N) How to Apply Online for B.Ed. Course for the 2016-18 Session

- Go to www.bkgc.org and Click on “**Apply Online for B.Ed.**”.
- Read the instruction and click Proceed.
- Carefully fill up the form and provide information regarding ‘Personal Details’, ‘Guardians’ Details’, ‘Address and Communication’ and Academic Details of All examination. Then click ‘Next’.
- In the next page fill-up the form and provide information regarding ‘Marks Obtained at different examination’ and then select the Subject you want to apply. Then click ‘Next’.
Enter Teaching Experience Details (only For deputed Candidate)
- Application Preview page is displayed. Carefully check the information in this page. If you want to make any changes click ‘Back’ button.
- If you are satisfied with the form click ‘Save’. A message will appear warning you to review the information carefully since you will not be able to make any changes once it is submitted. Press ‘OK’.
- Application Submitted page is displayed. **Note down your unique Application ID.**
- Print your Bank Chalan Copy.
- Pay application fees of Fresher-Rs. 700/- or Deputed-Rs. 1000/- with any additional charges of Bank through Canara Bank, MG Rd Howrah Branch.
- Once again log in to your account by your **Application ID** and Date of Birth.
- Insert your transaction id and submit your application.
- After successful submission print your application form.
- Wait for announcement of Merit List and Counseling Date.
- **If enlisted appear for Counseling at the Stipulated time with the printed Application Form (2 copies) and transaction proof along with all the required documents in original for verification on the day of Counseling cum admission.**
- Candidature will be cancelled if a candidate failed to submit the entire required document.
- After admission a candidate may apply for Hostel Facility.

O) Generals Rules:

- ❖ No Application and upgradation of qualification shall be entertained after the last date of online application what so ever the reasons may be.
- ❖ Any **wrongful information/mistake at any stage will lead to cancellation of candidature** even after payment of fees.
- ❖ Candidate should be report 30 minutes before the schedule time of counseling.
- ❖ Candidature will be cancelled if a candidate failed to appear on time for counseling.
- ❖ For any kind of dispute regarding admission related matters, the decision of the College Authority shall be final.
- ❖ After admission to the college if a candidate is found remain absent during 1st fifteen days from the commencement of classes, his/her name will be struck off from the roles without any further information to her and the seat will be treated as vacant.
- ❖ The B.Ed. programme shall be of duration of two academic sessions, which can be completed in a maximum of three years from the date of admission to the programme.
- ❖ 75% attendance is compulsory upon the delivered lecture to sit in College and University Examination.
- ❖ Students must be bound to follow the rules and regulations of the college and University.
